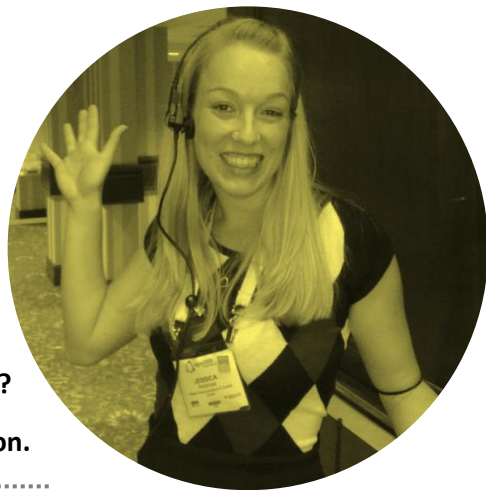


Event Management internships

To support and inspire both non-profits, like yours, and young professionals to work in this sector, we have created the *Event Management Internship program*.

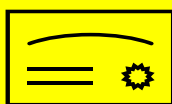
HOW IT WORKS

We provide participating partners with an “Internship Scholarship” that you can promote in your organisation. You can then award this scholarship to one of your staff or volunteers who you feel would make a great event manager and would be interested in interning with your organisation as part of their training.

The student gains their event management qualification, enjoys reduced course fees and gains real world experience at your organisation, which you know they already love. You get a spare set of hands for your events team! It’s a win-win.

Do I need to pay my intern?

Not usually. The work placement is a mandatory part of a nationally accredited course hence it is a non-paid vocational placement under Fairwork (Click here for [factsheet](#)). However, if you are offering the scholarship to a member of staff who is already paid to do an events role, then that payment would continue.

What does the intern do?

An internship will typically be around 3 months and have the intern working as part of your team whilst gaining real world experience and training for their portfolio.

What is the scholarship?

To support and inspire young professionals to develop their career with a non-profit internship we award a scholarship that reduces their course fees significantly.
